

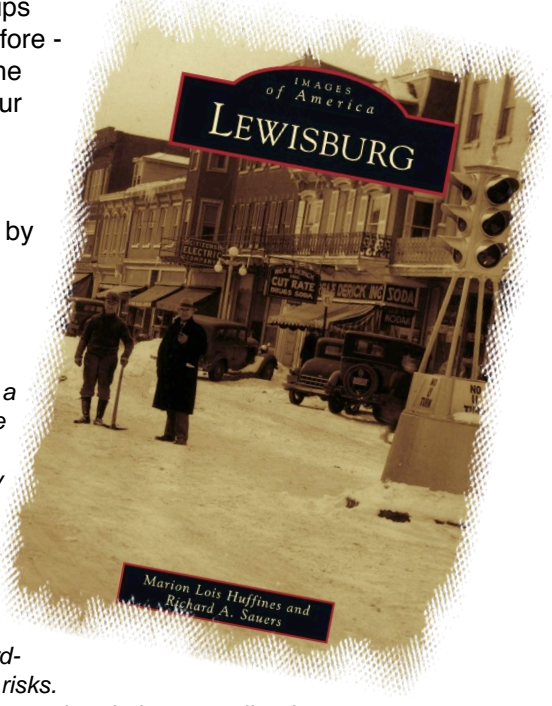
Order now!! The pictorial history of Lewisburg!

See the history of Lewisburg, Kelly and East Buffalo Townships through period photographs - many you have surely never seen before - of businesses, churches, schools, farms, street scenes, parades, the Susquehanna and so much more. You may even see photos of your own ancestors!

Lewisburg, by the Union County Historical Society and Packwood House Museum, is part of the Images of America series by Arcadia Publishing. This 128-page volume is authored by Lois Huffines (UCHS Board President) and Richard Sauers (Packwood House Executive Director).

Lewisburg has always been a center of trade and culture as a river and canal town on the banks of the Susquehanna River. Once served by two railroads and a tiny airport, Lewisburg's bridges and roads connected it to distant cities and rich hinterlands. Even today ... it has the resources of a city but the charm of a small town still surrounded by farms and fields. Elegant 18th and 19th century homes grace its streets, and churches cluster on many of its corners. The story of the town and adjacent Kelly and East Buffalo Townships reveals the great story of small-town America. Lewisburg and its surrounding townships prospered because of hard-working people, people with ideas, vision, and a willingness to take risks.

This new book will enable readers to connect to their past, remember their own earlier days, and gain an understanding of how history influenced the town we know today. ~ Lois Huffines
